

**Application for Departmental Transfer for UW-Madison Students
Enrolled in an Engineering Department or Another School or College**

DEADLINES: November 1st for Spring admission and March 1st for Fall admission

This application is for current UW-Madison students who (1) are enrolled in another school or college and want to transfer to a degree-granting program in the College of Engineering, or (2) are enrolled in an engineering degree-granting program and want to transfer to a different engineering program.

This application will be considered at the end of the semester.

To be considered for admission to a degree-granting program, you must have completed or be completing:

- At least 24 credits overall (can be AP or transfer credits)
- Communication Part A (EPD 155 or equivalent)
- Physics: either EMA 201 or Physics 201
- Chemistry: either Chem 109 or Chem 103-104
- Introduction to Engineering class from approved list (recommended but not required for transfer students)
- Math: Math 221 (or 217, or 275) and Math 222 (or 276)
- At least 17 credits in the calculus, statistics, chemistry, physics, computer science, and statics courses required for an engineering degree; at least a 2.5 grade point average* in these courses
- At least a 2.0 grade point average in all other courses

Admission depends upon program capacity; the GPA requirements can be higher as demand trends change. Your academic progress at UW-Madison will also be considered. If you are accepted, but are carrying fewer than 12 credits this semester, your admission will be on probation.

* If you are a transfer student to UW-Madison from another college/university, transfer grades will be included in this calculation.
