To be considered for admission to a degree-granting classification, you must have completed or be completing:

- At least 24 credits overall (can be AP or transfer credits)
- Communication Skills A (EPD 155 or equivalent)
- Physics: either EMA 201 or Physics 201
- Chemistry: either Chem 109 or Chem 103-104 (students who plan to take more advanced chemistry courses are encouraged to take Chem 109)
- Introduction to Engineering class from approved list (can be waived for transfer students)
- Math: Math 221 (or 217, or 275) and Math 222 (or 276)
- At least 17 credits in the calculus, statistics, chemistry, physics, computer science, and statics courses required for an engineering degree; at least a 2.5 average in these courses
- At least a 2.0 average in all other courses

This application will be examined soon after the **November 1st** deadline for spring admission and after **March 1st** for fall admission. If you are not accepted then, it will be reviewed when grades for the current semester become available. If you are accepted, but are carrying less than 12 credits this semester, your admission will be on probation.
